Title: **SUSTAINABLE PROCUREMENT POLICY**

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Antipollution, a member of V Group, operates consistently in the field of environmental management and recognizes that the responsible selection and evaluation of its suppliers constitutes a fundamental pillar for ensuring sustainability. The Sustainable Procurement Policy is fully integrated into the Integrated Management System and reflects the company's strategic commitment to minimizing environmental and social risks within its supply chain, while ensuring quality, reliability, and cost-effectiveness.

This Policy applies to all procurement activities of the company, covering all materials, raw materials, equipment, and services. It applies across all company locations and activities, including headquarters, facilities, projects, construction sites, and any other operational function, as well as any future expansion of the organization.

The Company's Management establishes and is committed to implementing this Policy, prioritizing the following principles:

- ❖ Selection and cooperation with suppliers that comply with applicable environmental and social legislation and align with recognized standards such as ISO 14001, ISO 26000, and SA 8000.
- ❖ Inclusion of suppliers in evaluation processes based on environmental and social criteria, in addition to cost and quality considerations.
- ❖ Adoption of pollution prevention criteria, greenhouse gas emissions reduction measures, and resource efficiency practices at every stage of the supply chain.
- ❖ Promotion of initiatives against child labor and forced labor, ensuring fair wages and decent working conditions throughout the supplier network.
- ❖ Enhancement of transparency in supplier relationships, maintaining zero tolerance toward corruption and conflicts of interest.

The company establishes annual supplier monitoring objectives, conducts evaluations based on performance indicators, and integrates the results into its annual sustainability reports. It identifies and assesses risks arising from cooperation with non-compliant suppliers and takes timely mitigation and improvement measures.
